Debbie and I enjoy the birds that frequent our back yard oasis. We keep a little water in the bird baths and keep the feeders full. We have regular visits from songbirds, a variety of finches, thousands of dove and sparrows, and a greedy assortment of hummingbirds; with one bully that spends most of his day trying to drive the other hummers away.



We are not fond of the squirrels that steal from the feeders. In our vain attempt to limit their access to the bird seed we have tried a variety of feeders, the latest being a model with a fence-like enclosure around it. The birds get in but the squirrels can't. Last Monday a bird got inside the fence only to get his head caught in the feeding station. Debbie and I went to help. The bird actually calmed down when we took the feeder off the hook, removed the lid, and turned it upside down to dump out the seed. Debbie surgically removed the trapped bird by sticking her hand inside the now empty feeder tube from the top and shoving the birds head back out. It's a little know medical procedure called a feederectomy! He (or she...who knows with sparrows?) didn't stick around to say thanks after we set him/her free. She/he just flew away.

We too have been set free. That is what the gospel does. It frees us from sin's penalty, practice, and presence. One of my theology mentors said that we have been freed from the penalty of sin, we are being freed from the practice of sin, and we will be freed from the presence of sin. But I am wondering today if we give serious attention to thanking the one who has freed us? Or do we just fly away?

Worship is one of the ways we say thanks to God for His gift of grace that sets us free. I am glad to be here with you today. Let us thank Him together. Let us worship.
